Rev. Bartholomew J. Juncer is a priest of the Canons Regular of St. John Cantius in the Archdiocese of Chicago. Fr. Juncer graduated from Quigley Preparatory Seminary in Chicago. He holds Bachelor of Arts degrees in Theology and in Communication Arts, and Master’s degrees in Religious Education and School Administration. As a layman, Father served Catholic schools throughout the Archdiocese as a teacher of Catholic theology, assistant principal, and dean of students.

In 2002, Fr. Juncer was ordained a deacon, and entered the Canons Regular of St. John Cantius in 2004. He completed his studies at Holy Apostles Seminary, was ordained to the priesthood on May 29, 2008, and currently serves as Associate Pastor at St. John Cantius in Chicago.
